



Uniform Policy

RATIONALE

School uniform engenders a pride in the school and identifies the school within the community

PURPOSES:

To establish guidelines for appropriate uniform for our school.

GUIDELINES:

1. The school uniform is set out in Appendix One. The Board may vary the uniform from time to time with appropriate consultation and notice to the school community.
2. The uniform is affordable for the majority of families, and we endeavour to ensure some second-hand stock is available. Assistance is available to family's experiencing hardship.
3. New entrants and new students at all year levels and their families are issued with a uniform list; and the uniform list is sent out at the change of season via the school newsletter.
4. All students are required to wear full uniform at all times, unless prior notice of a non-uniform day.
5. Students may wear the correct uniform in accordance with the gender they identify with.
6. A note is required from parents/caregivers in the event that full uniform is not worn, in which case an exemption may be granted for a limited period.
7. Items of school uniform are sold by the Uniform Shop at school to ensure a consistent approach to the uniform.
8. Jewellery, such as rings, bracelets, earrings (except two plain studs, one in each ear) and necklaces (except a small cross and chain or small cultural necklace), is not worn with school uniform.
9. Long hair below the collar is worn tied back. Hair is not dyed or bleached.
10. Makeup or nail polish is not worn with school uniform.

APPENDIX ONE – Uniform policy

In August 2022 the Board agreed to some changes to the Uniform policy. These will be phased in from Term 4, 2022 – until January 2025.

BOYS WINTER

- Navy blue shorts (Grey woollen shorts may be worn until phased out in term one, 2025).
- Long sleeve blue polo knit shirt or long sleeve blue cotton dress shirt (Y1-6)
- Long sleeve blue cotton dress shirt (Y7 - 8)
- Maroon woollen jersey or navy vest
- Maroon tie (Y7 - 8)
- Grey socks with colour band (maroon/navy)
- Black school shoes

BOYS SUMMER

- Navy blue shorts (Grey summer shorts may be worn until phased out in term one, 2025).
- Short sleeve blue cotton dress shirt or polo knit shirt (Y1 -6)
- Short sleeve blue cotton dress shirt (Y7 - 8)
- Maroon woollen jersey or navy vest
- Black school shoes
- Navy blue short socks (Grey socks with colour band (maroon/navy) may be worn until phased out in 2025).
- **Or** black, brown or navy dress sandals
- Navy school bucket hat

GIRLS WINTER

- Blue and red tartan pinafore (Y1- 6) or Navy culottes (Y1-6)
- Blue and red tartan skirt or Navy culottes (Y7 & 8)
- Long sleeve blue cotton dress shirt or polo knit shirt (Y1-6)
- Long sleeve blue cotton dress shirt (Y7 - 8)
- Maroon tie (Y7 - 8)
- Maroon woollen jersey or navy vest
- Navy tights or navy knee length cotton socks
- Black school shoes

SUMMER

- Blue and red tartan pinafore (Y1 - 6) or Navy culottes (Y1-6)
- Blue and red tartan skirt (Y7 - 8) or Navy culottes
- Short sleeve blue cotton shirt or polo knit shirt (Y1-6)
- Short sleeved blue cotton dress shirt (Y7-8)
- Maroon woollen jersey or navy vest
- Black school shoes or Black, brown or navy dress sandal

- Knee length navy cotton or short white socks
- Navy school bucket hat

PE UNIFORM FOR ALL STUDENTS

- Maroon school polo shirt and navy shorts
